

Eagle Scout Application Procedure and Route Sheet.

Please read the Eagle Scout leadership Service Project Workbook in its entirety, including the back cover. Many of your questions can be answered in this book. Fill in the NFC route sheet completely.

To expedite this process it is recommended that your advancement chair obtain a council copy of your scout records to compare to your unit records.

ROUTE SHEET INSTRUCTIONS

STEP ONE - The Route Sheet is for one Eagle Scout candidate and is filled out with the candidate's and unit leader's name before the Life Scout has his first contact with a Representative of the District Advancement Committee and before any actual work begins on his Eagle Scout Service Project. Be sure to have all initialed and signatures where designated.

STEP TWO – After the project is completed and the Eagle candidate completes all his paperwork, has had his scoutmaster conference, he brings the completed application package to the Representative of the District Advancement Committee who approved his project for review.

STEP THREE - The Advancement Committee Representative takes or mails the Eagle Scout application and Route Sheet to the Scout Service Center.

STEP FOUR - If the application is found to be defective by the Scout Service Center, the Advancement Committee Representative follows up with the unit leadership to correct the problem.

STEP FIVE - If the application is correct and complete, the Eagle Scout application is sent back to the District Advancement Committee Representative who then sets up the Eagle Board of Review with the respective Scoutmaster.
