## Requirements:

- Prerequisite Training: Youth Protection, Safe Swim Defense & Climb on Safely
- Current BSA Medical form A-C
- Swim test
- Attendance at all 4-days is required (We typically do Thursday evening to Sunday evening)
- Participation in a minimum of 10 activities is required to earn Powder Horn Award\*

\*Participants are NOT required to physically take part in any activity they are uncomfortable with. They may choose to observe and learn and will still get credit for that activity.

## Powder Horn

Powder Horn is a high adventure resource management course designed to introduce Scouting's adult and youth leaders to the exciting program possibilities for their Unit.

Many Scouting adult and youth leaders face the dilemma of having a strong desire to provide challenging and fun outdoor programs to meet the needs of their older youth members, but lack the knowledge and/or resources to do so.

Powder Horn responds to the quandary with an exciting new opportunity that introduces Venturing, Varsity, Sea Scout, and Scouts BSA adult/youth leaders and Cub Scout leaders to a wide range of safely conducted outdoor/high adventure activities of a fun and challenging nature. More importantly, Powder Horn provides its participants with valuable resources and contacts to assist them in delivering the promise of Scouting's high adventure to youth.

## Approach

The Powder Horn course contains a variety of topics made by knowledgeable consultants who demonstrate the skills required and explain where resources, such as equipment, facilities, guides, instructors and certifications can be obtained locally. Many presentations involve actual hands-on experience by the participants.

Under NO CIRCUMSTANCES is any Powder Horn participant required to participate in an activity they are uncomfortable with. They may choose just to observe and learn.

## Details

- Powder Horn is for BSA registered adult leaders, Venturing Scouts and Scouts BSA age 14+.
- Course is one long weekend from Thursday evening through Sunday evening.
- Basecamp will be near Ocala, FL.
- Lodging will most likely be cabin or lodge rooms.
