## How do I register?

- Go to [www.nfscouting.org/daycamp](http://www.nfscouting.org/daycamp)
- Select the camp you wish to attend. You will be redirected to the online registration page for that camp.
- Read details of the camp.
- Click on the "register today" button at bottom of page and log in to your account or create an account.

## How much does it cost to go camp?

To attend Camp, a Scout must have completed kindergarten by the start of camp and be a registered Cub Scout.

- **\$169** is the early bird fee to attend Cub Scout Day Camp if you have completed online registration by April 15, 2019 by 5:00 p.m.
- **\$199** is the regular fee to attend Cub Scout Day Camp if you have completed registration by May 31, 2019 by 5:00 p.m., and **\$229** is the late fee for any camp that starts within 2 weeks of the camp.
- Tot Lot is **\$49**
- **\$60** optional transportation to Day Camp

## What happens if I change my mind about coming to camp?

For refunds, visit our website at [www.nfscouting.org](http://www.nfscouting.org) and click on the link at the top for our refund policy. Youth or adults asked to leave camp for disciplinary reasons will not receive a refund.

## Camperships:

We do not want any Scout to miss out on the opportunity to attend Summer Camp due to financial need. Limited funds are available to assist families in need in North Florida Council. Campership applications are available at [nfscouting.org](http://nfscouting.org) under Council Forms. Applications must be received on or before April 1, 2020 for consideration.

## Volunteer Opportunities

For the safety of our Cubs, all adult volunteers must be registered with the Boy Scouts of America and will need to complete Youth Protection training online AND fill out a camp staff application (can be found [NFCScouting.org/daycamp](http://NFCScouting.org/daycamp)).
